SUMMARY

Teresa de Noronha is Full Professor of Economics at the Faculty of Economics, University of Algarve, Portugal.

She is the present President of the Board of Counselors (2015 -) and was past chairman of the Executive Committee of the CIEO - Research Centre for Spatial and Organizational Dynamics www.cieo.ualg.pt (2007 – 2015).

She is the Director of the Doctoral Program in Innovation and Land Use Management (2009 -), lectures and coordinates the courses in Regional Economics and Economics of Innovation at the Faculty of Economics of that same University.

Living in Canada since 2011, she commutes frequently between Faro and Toronto. In Toronto she has developed research at Cities Center, University of Toronto, as guest Professor, 2011/2012. She was an affiliate member of the Martin Prosperity Institute, School of Management of that same university from 2012 to 2014.

Teresa de Noronha has an international academic career. After having studied and researched at the University of Göttingen and University of Hannover, as a research assistant (1987-1991) and post-doctoral fellow at CSIC, Madrid, (1995-1996), ENSA and INRA Montpellier and Paris (1994-1996), she travelled as a guest Professor at the most renowned Universities: ATOM, Université Paris I, Sorbonne, (2001-2002); Department of Marketing, University of Gent (2003-2004); Department of Statistics, University of Bologna, Italy (2009, 2010), Cities Centre, University of Toronto, (2011-2013). Also, she lectured and provided institutional guidance, also in the framework of European project TEMPUS TACIS, at the following universities and institutes: University of Oriel, Russia, Université de Reims Champagne-Ardenne, Institute of Development Paranaense, Curitiba, Brazil. In Portugal, besides the Algarve University she lectured in Master and PhD programs at the Superior Institute of Agronomy, Technical University of Lisbon and the Department of Management, University of Beira Interior.

Her recent research points to the frontiers of innovation and local development as well as agrofood economics. She analyzes different behaviors of economic agents in a context of spatial dynamics, in particular of peripheral areas to analyse sustainability and prospect for local development. She also writes about the importance of knowledge management in the development process. She coordinated projects funded by the European Commission and national, regional and local agencies (Portuguese Foundation for Science and Technology, Commission for Coordination and Development of the Algarve). She also participated in multiple projects with funding of these same entities and in programs such as the KB, MED and TEMPUS from the European Commission.

To date, she has edited and authored numerous books and book chapters related to regional and innovation economics, management in small businesses and local development. Having produced an extensive amount of scientific published materials, she also supervised a significant number of master and PhD theses.
