Objectives

The Masters in Finance aims at providing students with a thorough understanding in the areas of Corporate Finance and Financial markets.

Organization

The Masters in Finance is a two-year course with 120 ECTS. After enrolling in the program, students are required to attend a one-year taught course (60 ECTS). There are seven compulsory courses, which provide the grounding that students require to fully understand the key theoretical concepts in finance. There are also two electives, which allow students to specialize in areas they are interested in. After the first year, students are required to write and present an original dissertation, which must be completed within one year (60 ECTS).
